

PHUTTA YODFA BRIDGE - THAILAND

The Memorial Bridge is a bridge over the Chao Phraya River in Bangkok, in Thailand, connecting the districts Phra Nakhon and Thonburi.

Construction of the bridge was started on 3 December 1929, in Middlesbrough, England.

The total length of the bridge is 678 meter.

In the middle of 2011, the bridge was regalvanised using ZINGA.

For aesthetical reasons, the ZINGA was overcoated with a local topcoat.
